



Understanding the Registry Close a Certification - Adverse Event

In the process of closing a certification, it is required that you report when a patient experiences any Adverse Event(s) while using medical marijuana.

Step 1: Click “Yes,” for the question “Has the patient had any Adverse Event(s) while using medical marijuana? Medication?” Then click “NEW ADVERSE EVENT.”

Step 2: You are brought to the Adverse Event screen. Enter all applicable details for the Adverse Event. Then, click “SAVE.”

Step 3: Once you have clicked “SAVE,” you are brought to the “Close Physician Certification” screen. Click “CLICK HERE TO SIGN CERTIFICATION.”
