The requestor must submit a redacted copy of the request redacting <u>only</u> those items identified as exempt concurrent with the submission of this form. Failure to provide a redacted copy at the time of submission, or failure to identify and redact information claimed as trade secret or otherwise exempt from disclosure may result in the release of all information in response to a public records request unless the information falls under another public records exemption.
