Pursuant to Emergency Rule 64ER22-7, an MMTC must obtain prior approval from the Department of Health, Office of Medical Marijuana Use (OMMU) for use of all websites or website purchasing by submitting this form and all required documentation.

Upon receipt of the completed request form and required documentation, the OMMU will send written notice to the MMTC either permitting use of the website or website purchasing or identifying any omissions, deficiencies, or violations.

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### Supporting Documentation Checklist

#### Website

- The proposed website URL does not contain any words or phrases that specifically target individuals under the age of 18.
- Documentation showing the proposed website will contain the following information:
  - Each marijuana and low-THC product available for purchase, including the form, strain of marijuana from which it was extracted, cannabidiol content, tetrahydrocannabinol content, dose unit, total number of doses available, and the ratio of cannabidiol to tetrahydrocannabinol for each product.
  - The price for a 30-day, 50-day, and 70-day supply at a standard dose for each marijuana and low-THC product available for purchase.
  - The price for each marijuana delivery device available for purchase.
  - If applicable, any discount policies and eligibility criteria for such discounts.

#### Website Purchasing

- Evidence that the website purchasing will only be available on the MMTC's Department-approved website.
- Documentation evidencing the MMTC's compliance with the standards enumerated under Emergency Rule 64ER22-7(5)(b) to ensure the confidentiality of all patient and caregiver information.

#### *How to Claim a Public Records Exemption*

If the MMTC intends to claim any exemption from public records disclosure under pursuant to section 119.07, Florida Statutes, it must indicate on the request the specific sections for which it claims an exemption and the statutory basis for the exemption. The requestor must submit a redacted copy of the request redacting **only** those items identified as exempt concurrent with the submission of this form. Failure to provide a redacted copy at the time of submission, or failure to identify and redact information claimed as trade secret or otherwise exempt from disclosure may result in the release of all information in response to a public records request unless the information falls under another public records exemption.
