Understanding Patient Profiles


Step 1: Log into the Medical Marijuana Use Registry, MMURegistry.FLHealth.gov.

Step 2: Click the "People Search" menu option at the top of the page. Enter the individual's information, then click "Search." To learn how to search for a person, [click here](#).

Step 3: If there is a match to the information you entered, the individual's profile will automatically populate.

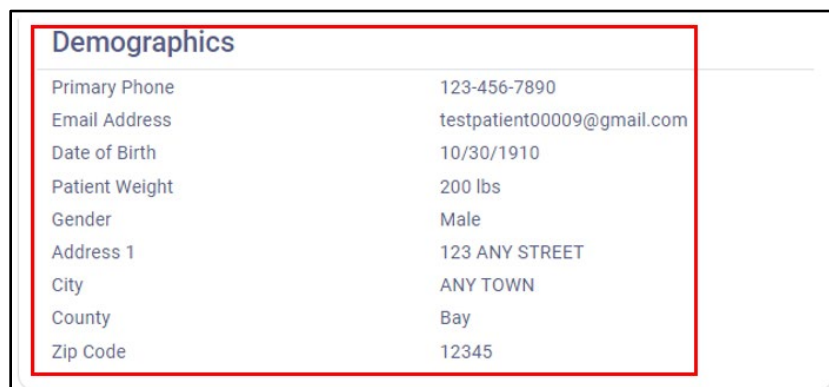
Step 6: Next, is the patient’s current physician’s information, Florida residency status, and assigned caregiver details. You may click the hyperlinked names to view any details related to the current physician or assigned caregiver.



Step 7: The “Authorized to Possess” section summarizes what the patient or caregiver is currently authorized to possess. A green checkmark indicates “Authorized” or “Valid” while a red “X” indicates “Not Authorized” or “Not Valid.”



Step 8: The individual’s demographic section contains any demographic information relevant to law enforcement.
