Amount Available Calculation Page

This guide will help Medical Marijuana Treatment Center (MMTC) staff understand the Amount Available Calculation page under the patient's profile. This page will provide information on how much product has been dispensed to a patient in the supply period, how much available product the patient can be dispensed, and their dispensation history.

Step 1: Log into the Medical Marijuana Use Registry, MMURegistry.FLHealth.gov.

Step 2: Navigate to the patient's profile and look to the right-hand side to view the patient's open orders.
