## Understanding the Registry Deactivate a Patient

Qualified physicians deactivate the registration of a qualified patient and the patient's caregiver when the physician no longer recommends the medical use of marijuana for the patient and the treatment is discontinued.

**Step 1:** Log into the Medical Marijuana Use Registry <u>https://mmuregistry.flhealth.gov/</u>.

Step 2: Navigate to the "Patient Management" menu option at the top of the page and click on "My Patients."

**Step 3:** Locate the patient you want to deactivate.

**Note:** Any open or scheduled orders for the patient <u>remain open</u> after you deactivate the patient and can still be dispensed. Cancel any orders you wish to terminate prior to deactivating the patient from your care.

Step 4: From the patient's profile, click "Edit Demographics."
