Understanding the Registry Physician Dashboard

To improve efficiency and streamline access to key tasks and monitor recent actions, a Physician Dashboard feature has been added to the Registry for qualified physicians. This feature provides physicians with direct navigation links to commonly used pages relevant to their daily responsibilities. Upon logging in, qualified physicians will notice a menu option titled "Physician Dashboard." This guide will go over the content that is included on this dashboard.


Viewing The Physician Dashboard

Step 1: Log into the Medical Marijuana Use Registry, <u>MMURegistry.FLHealth.gov</u>. *If you do not remember your password, learn how to reset it by <u>clicking here</u>.*

Step 2: Click the "Physician Dashboard" menu option at the top of the screen.




Overview of Physician Dashboard

"Certification Documentation" Section

The "Certification Documentation" section lists the number of documents that are "Not Yet Submitted" and "Needing More Information." Clicking on the hyperlinked numbers in these sections will take you to the corresponding webpage showing a tabulated list of the selected document.




The image below shows an example, as if you clicked the hyperlinked number next to "ARF Documents" from the "Documents Not Yet Submitted" subsection.


"Manage Your Profile" Section

"Patient Certifications" Section


